CHAIRMAN'S OPENING REMARKS

So wrote Robert Louis Stevenson, and, as a Scot, he will have known about rough weather. It is not clear whether he himself actually experienced the sensation of curling up in the heather to spend a night under the stars, but he certainly writes as if he did. I have spent many a memorable night this way - the rain, snow and brilliant starlight - and ! sometimes wonder why people regard such a bivouac as a Fate Worse Than Death.

I remember the time we were anchored from pitons on a narrow ledge in the Itali Dolomites, and as the wind howled around the frozen summit, one of my companions announced that his digestive tract was deeply moved by the experience, and would we dangle him over the ledge on the rope, so that he could lower his trousers? His wails, as the icy wind loyed with his sensibilities, were quite memorable. What fun I

These reflections were prompted by a wonderful week-end, when six of us, led by Barry, were in the Mzimude area of the 'Berg'. My companions seemed to have all sorts of hitech comforts to ensure a sweet and dreamless sleep, which quite put my rudimentary gear in the shade. But, for me, the days are long gone when I want to carry anything more than the bare necessities; so for the benefit of those who are wondering whether they have all the equipment necessary, take heart and consider the following:

- It's nice if you can find a convenient cave, but console yourselves with the thought that if you can't, the grass is more comfortable than the stony bed of a cave.
- Unfortunately, even in our wonderful climate, it can rain, so do not grudge the weight of thoroughly waterproof clothing - anorak, trousers and gloves
- Expensive sleeping bags are nice, but the same weight spare clothing is more useful, as it can be worn both night and day.
- 4. Space blankets are a wonderful invention with a suitable boulder, and a few stones to hold the blanket in position (shiny side facing you!) you can make your own cave. And, if your feet project outside put them in your rucksack which, or course, you have taken the precaution of lining with a plastic bag before you left home.
- As a small submission to the soft life, I carry a sleeping mat cut to fit inside the back my rucksack, and - wonderful luxury - a small air-pillow.
- 6 Armed with these simple things, plus a small plastic bottle containing the wine of Scotland, you can float away in the arms of Morpheus with no trouble at all !

When this reaches you I will be inhaling cooking draughts of healthful Manchester fog, from which well-known holiday resort I wish you sweet dreams and the compliments of the Season. I Yours ever. Bill


KROANNA HIKING TRAIL 28 TO 31 MARCH
